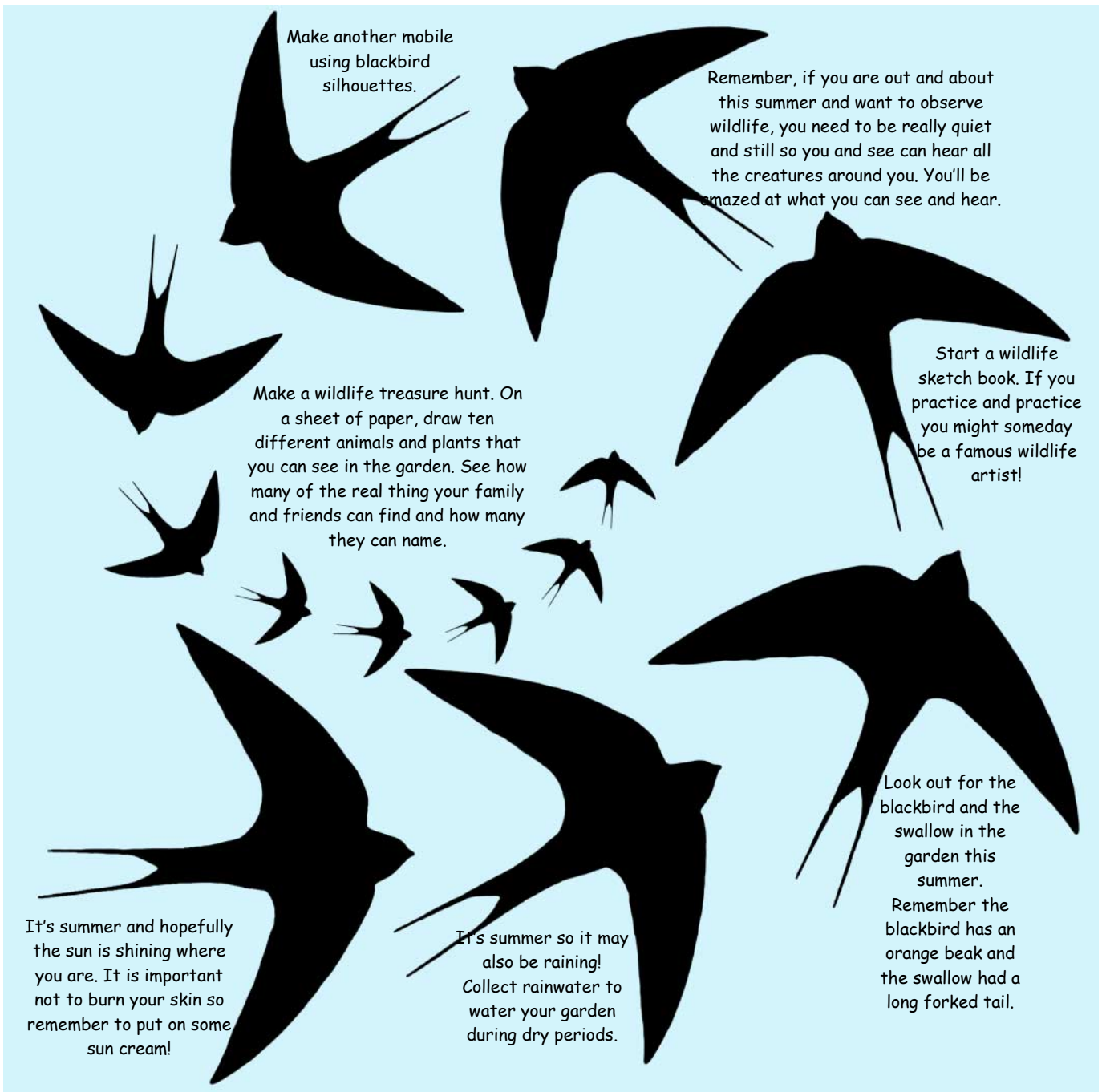


Nature's Noticeboard!
